2014 ELEMENTARY SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM**

**DESCRIPTION**

The Humble Independent School District offers a summer school program for elementary students in 5<sup>th</sup> grade who failed the second administration of the STAAR test in reading and math.

This summer program will be held at two campuses: Pine Forest Elementary, and Jack Fields Elementary. Campuses and special programs to be served at each location are listed in the chart below. Reading and Math for 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will be offered at both Pine Forest Elementary and Jack Fields Elementary.

Bilingual and English as a Second Language (ESL) programs are offered for students who are currently in PK4 and Kindergarten and who will be at least 5 years of age on or before September 1, 2014. This program will be held at schools as listed in chart below. The ESL Newcomer class for grades 3-5, will be held at the campuses as indicated, depending on enrollment.

Special Education programs, Extended School Year (ESY) will be held at the summer school locations as per the chart below.

**CRITERIA USED TO DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY FOR 5<sup>th</sup> GRADE-MATH AND READING**

For Grade 5, we will use the STAAR passing rates set for the 2013-2014 school year.

## **REGISTRATION**

Summer school registration will be completed **on-line at the student's home campus**. Information is available through the counselor's office or student's teacher.

## **TRANSPORTATION**

Parents who want their students to receive district transportation services must complete the Transportation Agreement as part of on-line registration for Humble ISD Elementary Summer School.

Only students with online registration and completed transportation information will be allowed to board the bus to Summer School.

Parents or guardians of summer school students who utilize district transportation **must commit to picking up students at the bus stops in a timely manner**.

**Supervision is never provided at the bus stops. If someone does NOT meet the bus for PK-K students, the student(s) be returned to the school. Any student returned to school 2 times will be suspended from the bus for the duration of summer school. Summer School campuses close at 4 pm. Supervision is NOT provided after this time.**

## **BREAKFAST AND LUNCH PROGRAM**

Humble ISD will serve a nutritious breakfast and lunch daily in the cafeteria. Breakfast will be served from 7:30 – 8:00 a.m. and lunch will be served from 11:15 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. **Lunches are available only for students attending the afternoon classes and for those students attending both morning and afternoon classes.** Prices for breakfast and lunch will be the same as for the regular school year. (Breakfast - \$1.30 and Lunch - \$2.10) Milk is served with all cafeteria meals. Additional milk is available at extra cost. Students who qualify for free or reduced breakfast/lunch during the school year will also qualify during summer school. A menu for breakfast and lunch will be made available to parents.

## **CLASS DESCRIPTIONS**

*(Grades refer to the current grade in which the student is enrolled.)*

### **1. Bilingual/ESL at Pine Forest Elementary and Jack Field Forest Elementary Grades Pre-K4 – K 8:00 a.m. – 3:15 p.m.**

This special language summer school program is offered at no cost to ELLs **who are currently** in Pre-K4 or in kindergarten, are served in an ESL or Bilingual program and who will be enrolled in an Humble ISD school in Kindergarten or 1<sup>st</sup> grade the following school year. The bilingual and ESL PK/K programs will be offered at PFE and JFE.

These students are identified according to state guidelines. The program focuses on the language development needs of these limited English proficient students.

### **2. Reading Instruction (Grade 5) at Pine Forest Elementary and Jack Fields Elementary *(Bilingual at Pine Forest and Jack Field Elementary)* 8:00 a.m. – 11:15 a.m. And 12:00 – 3:15 p.m.**

This course will be offered to students currently in grade 5 who failed or missed the second administration of the STAAR Reading test. This 10 day program is free.

### **3. Mathematics Instruction (Grade 5) *(Bilingual at Pine Forest and Jack Field Elementary)* 8:00 a.m. – 11:15 a.m. And 12:00 – 3:15 p.m.**

This course will be offered to students currently in grade 5 who failed or missed the second administration of the STAAR Math test. This 10 day program is free.

#### **4. Special Language Summer School for Newcomer BE/ESL students (Grades 3-5)**

*(Pine Forest and Jack Field Elementary)*

**8:00 a.m. – 11:15 a.m.**

The special language summer school program is offered to students who are in an ESL or BE program and are in their first three years of U.S. Schools. They also must, in the Spring of 2014, score below level 3.0 on the OLPT or B or I on the TELPAS composite. The program focuses on the language development needs of these limited English proficient students through the study of social studies content. This program is free to eligible students.

#### **SUMMER SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION--ELEMENTARY**

##### **MORNING SESSION:**

Buses will pick up students at the designated bus stops beginning at approximately 7:00 a.m.

##### **AFTERNOON SESSION:**

Buses will pick up students at the designated bus stops beginning at approximately 11:00 a.m.

##### **ESY CLASSES:**

Transportation will be provided for students with disabilities in the Extended School Year program when required by an ARD committee.

##### **BILINGUAL/ESL CLASSES AT JFE and PFE:**

Buses will pick up students at the designated bus stops beginning at approximately 7:00 a.m.

##### **BUS INFORMATION:**

Parents or guardians of summer school students who utilize district transportation must commit to picking up students at the bus stops in a timely manner.

**Supervision is never provided at the bus stops. If the parent is not present to meet the bus, any child who does not have written permission to walk will be returned to the school. Any student returned to school 2 times will be suspended from the bus for the duration of summer school. Summer School campuses close at 4 pm. Supervision is NOT provided after this time. Guardians or siblings must be 18 years of age or older to meet student.**
