

Humble ISD School Board Member Charles Cunningham elected President of the Gulf Coast Area Association of School Boards



Humble ISD school board member Charles Cunningham has been elected President of the Gulf Coast Area Association of School Boards (GCAASB) for the 2014-2015 school year. The association is composed of more than 50 school boards in the greater Houston area to enhance the quality of education for public school children in the Texas Gulf Coast area by providing education and information to local school boards, and creating an opportunity for local school boards to impact legislation affecting public schools.
