Many students hope to raise enough funds to take away Dr. Landry's tent. "Dr. Landry's response, 'Come and Take It,' has generated quite the buzz around campus," comments Kingwood High School student, Erica Thorpe.

Dr. Landry is set to be hoisted on the roof of Kingwood High School the morning of Thursday, Nov. 7, and a live feed will be available on the KHS and district homepages for viewing throughout the day, thanks to GMC Texan Live's donated technical support services. The community is invited to support this effort by visiting the KHS homepage online or donating in person at the varsity football game at Turner Stadium on Thursday, Nov. 7 at 7:00 p.m.

Kingwood High School Annual Fund Chairperson, Kindra Hefner, comments, "Look for Dr. Landry on the jumbotron during the varsity football game. There will be live updates about his experiences, and you can witness the supplies being taken away. I know the students are so excited about this."

In partnership with the Humble ISD Education Foundation, Kingwood High School has embarked on its first ever annual fund campaign. The KHS Annual Fund Campaign is the school's process to raise funds for areas of need. Through this fund, we can provide our students with the skills, tools, and experiences necessary to become productive adults and to be globally competitive.

Based on community feedback from last spring, three areas of need at Kingwood High School are technology infrastructure, professional development for teachers, and student activities. Concerning technology at Kingwood High School, administrators comment that they would love to provide ipad carts to be used in the classrooms as well as allow students to bring their own electronic devices; however, currently, they do not have the technology infrastructure to support these tools or opportunities.
