

CenturyLink surprises KMS teacher Michelle Neyrey with Technology Grant



Congratulations to Kingwood Middle School History teacher Michelle Neyrey, who was awarded the Clarke M. Williams Foundation’s CenturyLink Teachers and Technology grant. Neyrey was pleasantly surprised when she was handed a check for \$4,925 to purchase laptop computers to assist her History students.

Over 20 teachers applied for the CenturyLink Teachers and Technology grant and Neyrey was 1 of 7 teachers awarded grants in Texas. Neyrey has 15 years of teaching experience and has taught in Humble ISD for 8 years. She applied for the grant after she noticed that there was a need for more technology in the classrooms at KMS.

“Students today live in a technology world. If we don’t meet them as educators in their medium we will not make the connections that are so important to learning.” The new laptop computers will be used for research, writing papers, creating presentations and for presenting information to other classmates.
