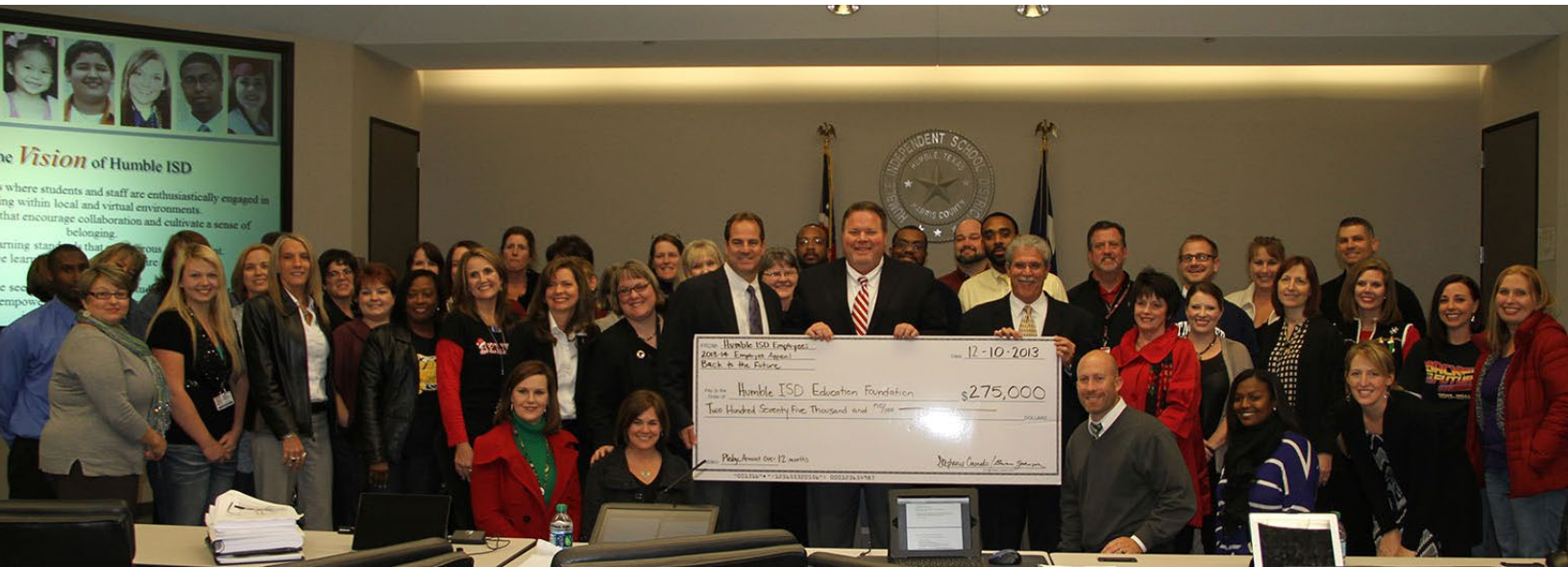


Education Foundation's employee campaign ends with record-breaking numbers



Humble ISD employees joined in presenting a check to the Humble ISD Education Foundation at the regularly scheduled December board meeting. Employee contributions totaled \$275,000, up from \$38,000 three years prior, and the most successful Humble ISD Education Foundation employee campaign to date.
