**Who is eligible:** Any student who has completed one of the following CareerSafe courses: OSHA 10-Hour General Industry, OSHA 10-Hour Construction Industry, OSHA 10-Hour General Industry (Agriculture). Each entry must have a sponsor (e.g. teacher, mentor, advisor, or parent/guardian).

**Submission Criteria:** Contest begins January 1, 2015 and ends December 31, 2015. The entry period for each quarter is as follows:

Quarter 1: January 1- March 31

Quarter 2: April 1 - June 30

Quarter 3: July 1 - September 30

Quarter 4: October 1 - December 31

### **Essay Requirements:**

- Must maintain the theme: How has your OSHA 10-Hour wallet card impacted how you recognize hazards and how it will benefit your future.
- 800 words or less
- Typed, double-spaced in 12-point Arial or an equivalent font
- Numbered pages with one-inch margins

**Top Prizes:** CareerSafe will select up to two (2) students to be awarded a \$500 scholarship each quarter.
