

Reassessment Parameters

A set of parameters will guide the use of reassessment for these courses. These parameters create an equal opportunity for all students in these courses and will be utilized by all teachers in these courses. They were created with the input of the teachers who teach these courses. The parameters are as follows:

If students in **Level Courses/Honors/PreAP Courses** want an opportunity to be reassessed on a summative assessment:

1. Students must have completed the assignment(s) pertaining to the objective(s) or section(s) they want to reassess.
2. If the re-learning of non-mastered material does not occur in the classroom, students will have to attend an arranged time to be tutored or receive additional help on the non-mastered material.
3. Students have a **deadline of one week** to reassess after receiving the original graded assessment.
4. Students may be reassessed on the objective(s) they missed and in the modality of choice the teacher selects, i.e., a different test, oral defense, written modes, explanations, demonstrations, etc. Again, it is the responsibility of the student to attend the reassessment.
5. The student gets **ONE** reassessment opportunity. If the student shows improvement on the objective(s) or section(s) reassessed, points earned will be added to the original assessment grade with a **CAP OF 85%** on the grade.

AP/Dual Credit: At this time, reassessment opportunities will not occur because some assignments cannot be reassessed in certain courses due to College Board guidelines.
