DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO REGISTER VEHICLE:

- 1.) **Driver's License** - Copy of Student's valid driver's license.
- 2.) **Proof of Insurance** - Copy of proof of valid insurance listing vehicle and student as an insured driver on that vehicle. ***(The student's name must appear on the insurance.)***
- 3.) **CASH ONLY \$25.00 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF TOWING POLICY AND RECEIPT OF PARKING REGULATIONS BOOK**

Vehicles shall be parked only in areas designated by the building principal for student parking. Students must park in the designated student parking lot at all times during the event of the school day. Motor vehicles that do not have a parking permit or are improperly parked may be towed away by a bonded commercial wrecker. It shall be the responsibility of the student and/or owner of the vehicle to pay for towing and storage charges. The Assistant Principal's office is to notify the student and/or owner where the vehicle has been taken. **Vehicles in the following areas may be towed:**

- AREAS INDICATED AND MARKED AS "FIRE ZONES"
- AREAS BLOCKING ROADWAYS, DRIVEWAYS, OR INTERSECTIONS
- AREAS BLOCKING ENTRANCES IN SERVICE DRIVEWAYS FOR DELIVERY AND/OR MAINTENANCE VEHICLES
- AREAS INDICATED BY "NO PARKING TOW AWAY" SIGNS
- AREAS MARKED "RESERVED"
- AREAS FOR TEACHERS AND VISITORS ONLY
- **PARKING ON BAND PRACTICE AREA AFTER 3:00 PM**

I acknowledge that I have read the parking and traffic regulations booklet regarding automobiles and parking and will abide by the regulations. I further understand that if my vehicle is parked illegally and it becomes necessary for it to be towed, all the expenses incurred will be my responsibility. **Also, I understand that my driving privileges and parking permit can be revoked without a refund, as a result of Code of Conduct violations such as, but not limited to: leaving school without permission (alone or with another person) and violations of the parking regulations.** No sticker will be replaced unless the old sticker, or a large portion of it, is brought in to the Assistant Principal's office. Vehicles parked on school property are under the jurisdiction of the school. The school reserves the right to search any vehicle if reasonable cause exists to do so. Students have full responsibility for the security of their vehicles and will make certain they are locked and their keys are not given to others. Students will be held responsible for any prohibited objects or substances, such as alcohol, drugs, and weapons, which are found in their cars and will be subject to disciplinary action. Searches of vehicles may be conducted at any time there is reasonable cause to do so, with or without the presence of the student.

Student Parking Rules and Regulations

Please read carefully, both you and your parent/guardian are responsible for the following rules and regulations. These Rules and Regulations must be adhered to at all times.

Student parking privileges can be revoked if the following Rules and Regulations are not followed.

1. To register a student's vehicle(s):
 - a. Have parent/guardian sign all applicable spaces.
 - b. Return the completed form to the front office along with proof of insurance (current), valid driver's license and \$25.00 for registration fee.
2. Each student will be sold only one tag. This tag must be in the vehicle that the student drives to school on any given day and that particular vehicle must be registered with the school in that student's name. Appropriate discipline will be applied if the student violates this rule.
3. ***Parking decal must be displayed clear view from the outside of the vehicle.*** Failing to properly display your parking tag is a violation of parking rules. Any student that has received two or more warning violations is subject to have the vehicle towed from the campus at the owner's expense.
4. If a parking decal is lost, the student is required to report it lost to the office and purchase another parking tag. The student will need proof of insurance (current), valid driver's license and pay the \$25.00 parking fee in order to be issued a new tag.
5. **A STUDENT MAY NOT USE ANOTHER STUDENT'S PARKING Decal AT ANY TIME.**
6. **THE SCHOOL IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR DAMAGE OR THEFT. TAKE ALL NECESSARY PRECAUTIONS TO PROTECT PERSONAL PROPERTY.**
7. Students may not go to their vehicle at any time during the school day without an authorized pass from a principal's office.
8. Students found parking in **UNAUTHORIZED AREAS** risk losing their parking privileges and/or having their vehicle towed, **at owner's expense.**

THE STUDENT MUST ADHERE TO ALL STUDENT PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS WITHOUT HESITATION OR DISCIPLINARY ACTION WILL BE TAKEN.

Parking Violation Consequences

Vehicles in violation of any of the above Rules or Regulations will be subject to the following consequences:

1st-3rd violation: Written warning sticker placed on vehicle.

4th violation: Parking Privileges suspended for 5 school days

5th violation: Loss of Parking Privileges for the Semester/or Remainder of school year

Any driving deemed unsafe or puts student(s) in harm as determined by school administration can result in removal of parking privileges immediately for the remainder of the school year.

A VEHICLE MAY BE TOWED (at owner's expense) IF ANY PART OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS ARE VIOLATED.

- Operators of motor vehicles on school property are subject to all Rules and Regulations of Humble I.S.D. School Board Policy and in some cases STATE LAW.
