Courses in MATH only require placement scores for TSI Math/Exemption.

Courses in BIOL, ECON, CHEM or PHYS require placement scores for both English and Math/Exemption.

Students wishing to begin their Dual Credit Math courses with a higher level Math such as PreCal or even Calculus directly must place into that level of course with either ACT, SAT or Accuplacer testing.

***PSAT/NMSQT is the ONLY PSAT score set we are approved to use for TSI Exemption. PSAT 8/9 are not eligible scores. The score report submitted to LSC must show NMSQT in order to be accepted.**

****Students who took the Accuplacer prior to 01/28/19 should contact Advising to determine their score.**

NOTE: Students should visit with their advisors to learn about other campus options such as refresher courses and non-course based options.
