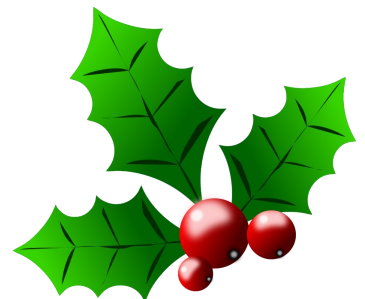
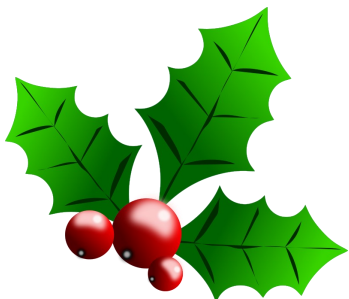

About the KPHS Madrigal Singers...

The Kingwood Park High School Madrigal Singers are an auditioned, varsity level mixed chamber ensemble comprised of 20 student-musicians, grades ten through twelve. Throughout the year, they focus on a vast array of musical styles and genres. During the Christmas Season, this ensemble is in high demand at community events throughout the greater Houston area to provide the songs of the season, and are thrilled to continue this traditional carols concert in Kingwood. Students from this ensemble are involved in many other academic events, fine arts, and athletics, such as baseball, cross country, football, softball, tennis, track, French Club, NHS, NEHS, NSHS, Key Club, and AISES.

About the KPHS Chamber Orchestra...

The Kingwood Park HS Chamber Orchestra is the varsity level orchestra comprised of 26 advanced musicians ranging from tenth through twelfth grade. The orchestra performs in concert and competitions throughout the year as well as solo & ensemble contest where many qualify for the Texas State Solo & Ensemble Contest every year. The orchestra performs for UIL Concert and Sight Reading contest where they consistently receive superior ratings. Students from this ensemble are involved in many other academic events, fine arts, and athletics, such as cross country, track and field, swim, tennis, wrestling, football, Silver Stars, NHS, NEHS, NSHS, NTHS, Key Club, Student Council, HOSA, FFA, AISES, Rho Kappa, UIL Computer Science, and GSA.

Kingwood Park High School Choral Director Ben Fahnders is in his seventeenth year of teaching, and his ninth year at Kingwood Park. A graduate of Humble High School, Mr. Fahnders received his undergraduate degree from Louisiana State University. Choirs under his direction consistently receive Superior Ratings at UIL Concert and Sightreading Competition. He is a member of TMAA, TMEA, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, and a lifetime member of the Texas PTSA.

Kingwood Park High School Orchestra Director Josh Taylor is in his eleventh year of teaching, seventh at KPHS. Originally from McMinnville, TN, he studied at Lee University where he received his Bachelor of Music Education in 2010. He has taught band, choir, orchestra, general music, theater, musicals, music theory, ESL, 6th grade math, 5th grade reading, and accompanied choirs in South Dakota, Tennessee, and Texas. He is a member of TODA and TMEA and serves as TMEA Region 33 Orchestra Division Chair.
