



Advanced Placement Testing Late Testing Policy

Humble ISD will ONLY permit late testing under specific circumstances that comply with College Board's Late Testing Policy. Documentation is required before a test can be ordered. A lack of proper documentation may result in a student not being able to take a late test on an alternate date. Student's missing an AP test for any other reason will not qualify to request late testing. A late testing fee of \$45 will be charged to students choosing to test on an alternate date.

The campus AP Coordinator and principal will make the final decision on whether the campus will administer a late test for a student. Students may be permitted to register for a late test on an alternate date in Humble ISD under the following circumstances:

- Family commitment (college/university graduation)
- Other school event
- Academic or athletic contest/event
- Ordering error

Alternate late exams will be given on May 17-19, 2017 as per College Board Policy.
