

# Lakeshore Elementary Student Council AGENT Candidates Rules and Regulations for Campaigning

1. Each candidate may have one poster to be placed in the hallway near the cafeteria.
    - Posters are to be created during an unofficial Student Council Meeting held after school.
    - Students must use the provided supplies only to create their individual campaign posters.
    - Posters must be created - in full, only during the “unofficial STUCO meeting” that afternoon.
    - Posters must be approved by the STUCO advisors prior to being hung.
  2. Speeches will be limited to 1 minute.  
Speeches must:
    - Include your name
    - Include the reasons you wish to be a part of Lakeshore Elementary’s Student Council.
    - You may promote your candidacy with a slogan or clever conclusion for your speech.
    - Speeches will be written by the candidate in persuasive form.
    - No songs, props, costumes, electronic devices, or music will be permitted.
  3. No other materials are to be used by a student for campaign purposes (stickers, buttons, T-Shirts, candy).

7. October 17th - Election Day - speeches given (During school hours -TBA)
8. October 22nd - 1st Official AGENTS meeting @3:45-5pm
