Expectations

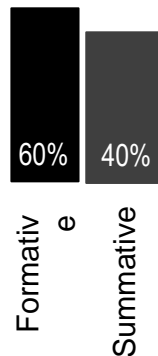
- 1.) Follow directions the first time they are given.
