# COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOLS

- **ALL staff and students are welcomed to wear masks. ESE will provide masks upon request.**
- **Disinfectant spray (or wipes) are used daily to wipe down desks/tables in classrooms.**
- **Misting machines are used daily after hours to further clean classrooms.**
- **Hand sanitizer is available in all classrooms and around campus.**
- **Specials classes are sanitized between classes.**
- **COVID-19 safety signage is displayed throughout campus.**
- **Students are educated about the importance of frequent hand washing, covering a cough or sneeze, and not touching one's face.**
- **Water fountains are not in use. Students must bring a personal water bottle that can be filled at our 3 filtered water bottle filling stations. *Parents are asked to consider donating small water bottles to your child's teacher for times that a child forgets their water bottle at home.***
- **Staggered dismissal times.**
- **All students will have 2 recess periods per day to increase access to fresh air and sunshine.**
- **Teachers have access to 5 outdoor learning areas to utilize when weather permits.**

# SELF SCREENING

- **All staff are required to self screen for CoVid symptoms and not to report to work, if sick.**
- **All parents are asked to please screen students for CoViD symptoms before school each day. We ask that sick students be kept at home.**
- **T.E.A. (Texas Education Agency) does not have a policy in place requiring close contacts to stay at home. Families with a CoVid positive child are asked to consider keeping siblings home for monitoring.**

# PHYSICAL DISTANCING & SHARING OF SUPPLIES

- **ESE currently has 608 On Campus Learners, an increase from the 434 On Campus Learners we had in August 2020. With the majority of our students on campus, we are working towards increasing opportunities for physical distancing including space between lunch tables and isolated classes at recess. We currently have these physical distancing measures in place:**
  - **Grade level assigned restrooms**
  - **Staggered classes in the hallways**
  - **Staggered dismissal times to decrease hallway traffic**
  - **PE classes will not mix**
- **Homeroom classes are like small “families.” Students will be taught to keep distance as much as possible and to wash/sanitize hands often.**
- **Personal supplies (pencils, crayons, etc.) will not be shared. Classroom materials, books, and technology will be shared. However, items will be sanitized between usages.**

# VISITORS

- **No visitors, including lunch visitors will be allowed at ESE until further notice. We hope to change that by the end of September, but will continue to monitor.**
- **Volunteers are limited to workroom volunteers who are completing tasks for our teachers. This is only a few individuals and all have been asked to self-screen for CoVid symptoms prior to entering ESE.**
- **Our high school volunteers who usually hand out information regarding programs and clinics will not come on campus. Instead, we will send home informational fliers.**

# BIRTHDAY RECOGNITIONS

- Parents wanting to recognize a child's birthday at school with treats may purchase frozen treats from the cafeteria for all students in the child's homeroom class at a cost of \$1 per child. Parents should put the money in the child's lunch account either online (*preferred*) or by sending a check or cash to school with the child.
- Due to CoVid, outside treats will NOT be allowed for birthday recognitions for the 2021-22 school year.
- *The following items are never allowed at ESE to recognize birthdays: balloons, goodie bags, gifts, candles, flowers, etc.*
- Visitors at lunch are not currently allowed. However, a parent wanting to eat lunch with a child on their birthday, can notify the teacher and front office. The parents and child may enjoy lunch together at one of our outdoor picnic tables.
