Health & Safety Measures to Prevent the Spread of CoVid-19

CAMPUS WIDE

- Daily cleaning procedures for all classrooms (desks/tables)
- Frequently touched objects and surfaces cleaned frequently. Use of fogging machines after hours to further clean the campus
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for staff and students. In keeping with the governor's directive all individuals over the age of 10 will be required to wear a mask. Masks, face shields and gloves will be available to staff
- Displayed signs throughout campus encouraging healthy habits
- Extra hand sanitizer available
- All staff responsible to educate students about the importance of frequent hand washing; covering a cough or sneeze; not touching one's eyes, nose, and mouth; and other health and safety measures.

CLASSROOMS & INSTRUCTION

- Hand sanitizer available in each classroom
- Each student will have own supplies; supplies will not be shared
- Use of flexible seating options to increase spacing to the extent possible
- Increased usage of outdoor learning spaces
- Frequent reminders about hygiene and safety in classroom meetings/community time
- Use of Morning Meetings to reinforce importance of health and safety measures
- Folders/take home readers sent home weekly, rather than daily; any daily communication would be electronic

MINIMIZING STUDENT CONTACT

- Classes will stay together as a group
- Increased space between classes during lunch
- Although 2 classes will attend PE at the same time, the classes will not mix
- Recess zones
- Scheduled restroom breaks by class to limit congregating in restrooms and to ensure proper handwashing

ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL

- Students will enter classrooms upon arrival at school, rather than sit in hallways
- Breakfast students will be seated apart; siblings may sit together
- Increase dismissal areas to allow for distancing

PARTNERING WITH FAMILIES

- Parents/Guardians can help by keeping children home who are sick, have symptoms, or are running a fever. Parents should closely monitor their children every morning prior to coming to school.
- Our school nurse is available to discuss current guidelines.
