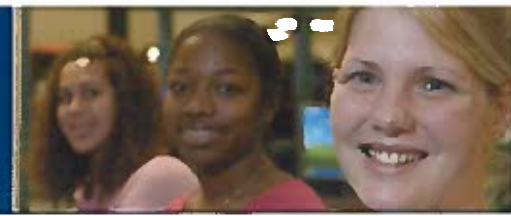

Tax Credit

You may also be eligible for either the Hope or Lifetime Learning tax credits which may be claimed when you file your taxes. For more information visit www.ed.gov/studentaid.

FAQs

Q: How will I be notified of my financial aid award?

A: You will be notified by campus e-mail of your award. You can check the amount of your award on your MyLoneStar account.

Q: Why am I not able to receive my award amount over the phone?

A: Due to the Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA), we are not able to disclose financial information over the phone.

Q: When are my funds disbursed to me?

A: Funds are released to students after official day of record.

Q: Can I receive aid at more than one school?

A: No, you may only receive financial aid from one school in a term.

Q: Can I get financial aid for summer classes?

A: Summer funds are determined by the amount of financial aid you received in the previous fall and spring terms. Please check with the financial aid office.

Q: What is the LSC-Kingwood Federal School Code for the FAFSA application?

A: 011145

Q: If I am not eligible for grants,

what are my options?

A: You may still be eligible to qualify for federal student loans, scholarships, and work study if you are not eligible for grants.

Q: I completed the FAFSA form last year. Why do I need to complete the application again this year?

A: Eligibility for financial aid is determined by using the previous year's earnings. Applying each year allows for changes in your family's financial information.

Q: I only want to apply for a loan. Why do I have to complete the FAFSA?

A: The FAFSA is used to determine eligibility for federal, state, and institutional aid. Loans are a type of federal aid and in order to receive student loan funds, you must comply with deadlines for submitting applications.

Types of Financial Aid

Texas Public Education Grant (TPEG)

An institutional grant with priority given to those students who have a high need.

Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (FSEOG)

A supplemental grant given to those students who have a high need.

Federal & State Work Study Programs

Programs to promote part-time employment of currently enrolled students.

William D. Ford Direct Loan Program

Subsidized and unsubsidized loans available to students who may or may not qualify for grants and need additional funds to complete the financing of their education. Loan funds must be repaid with interest to the lender.

Scholarships (internal and external)

Awards that help pay for tuition, fees, books and supplies.
