

## AHS DRESS CODE OVERVIEW

(The following are a summary of common dress code violations)

### NOT PERMITTED

- Sagging pants
- Visible undergarments
- Hats, caps, hoods, bandanas, or rags
- Excessively tight clothing of any kind
- Tops that are low-cut; expose midriffs; have spaghetti straps; are strapless; or are halter tops.
- Shirts with inappropriate messages
- Unnatural hair color
- Hair designs that distract
- Pajamas
- Males may not wear any type of earrings or sleeveless tops

### Specifics

- Shorts, dresses, or skirts may not be shorter than the length of an ID card from the top of the knee (including the back of the skirt and/or slits). This applies even if they are worn over leggings.
- Leggings, jeggings, and yoga pants (even if they flair) may only be worn with an article of clothing on top that is longer than **fingertip length** all the way around the body. All shorts, dresses, and skirts must be ID length from the top of the knee regardless of what is worn underneath.
- Females may only have pierced ears; no other visible piercings are permitted.
- Tattoos must be covered.
- Males must be clean shaven.
- Pants/jeans/shorts may not have holes that expose skin above the knee.

**Any student who does not comply with the dress code will be removed from the regular school setting until the student complies with this code. This does not cover all dress code requirements but is a summary of the most common violations.**
