What Are We Learning This Week?

MATH: We will add and subtract positive rational numbers. We will also multiply whole numbers up to a three digit by two digit. We will also multiply whole numbers by decimals.

SCIENCE: We will classify matter by its physical properties including mass, magnetism, physical state, relative density, and the ability to conduct or insulate thermal energy. We will also identify changes that occur in physical properties such as dissolving salt in water (mixtures and solutions).

SOCIAL STUDIES: We will celebrate
Constitution Day by learning about our United
States Constitution.

READING: Students will analyze the literary elements of Greek Mythology (a sub-genre of fiction). Students will select and begin to plan a project that will synthesize their knowledge of this genre.
