## Kindergarten Round-Up



Kindergarten Roundup is coming soon. It will help parents learn about the kindergarten program. Students must be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2018 to qualify for Kindergarten. The first day of school for the 2018-2019 school year is Monday, Aug. 20<sup>th</sup>. New Kindergarten parents will need to register their new student(s) online at:



After enrolling online, parents

can make an appointment with the Registrar to complete registration. Applications not processed with the registrar during our registration window will be removed and you will need to re-apply online. Bring the following documentation to complete registration:

- Child's Proof of Age and Proof of Identity (official birth certificate, adoption record, hospital birth record, passport or other legal document that establishes age and identity)
- Parent/Guardian's driver's license or passport for identification purposes
- Immunization records (all

records, including electronic My Chart) records, must be signed or stamped by the physician or his/her designee or public health personnel)

- Proof of residency in Humble ISD (utility bill, lease agreement, house closing statement).

Parents, please ensure that your child(ren) get plenty of rest the night before and arrive to school early enough on testing days to eat breakfast.

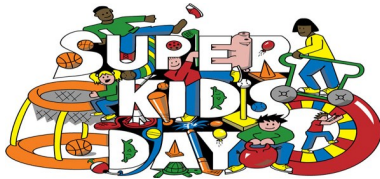
## 4 Annual Goals:

TYPINGCLUB is a fun way to learn how to type as well as to improve

typing skills. The site's best aspect is the learning potential it provides for kids. With a simple interface, beginning to advanced keyboarders can become better at touch-typing (using all of one's fingers, without looking at the keys).
