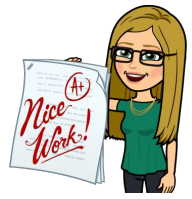

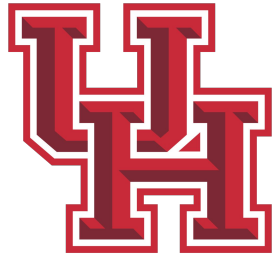
Our North Star Mission Statement



Everyday, Humble High School provides a challenging and innovative college, career, and life readiness experience that equips students to excel in the future endeavor of their choice.

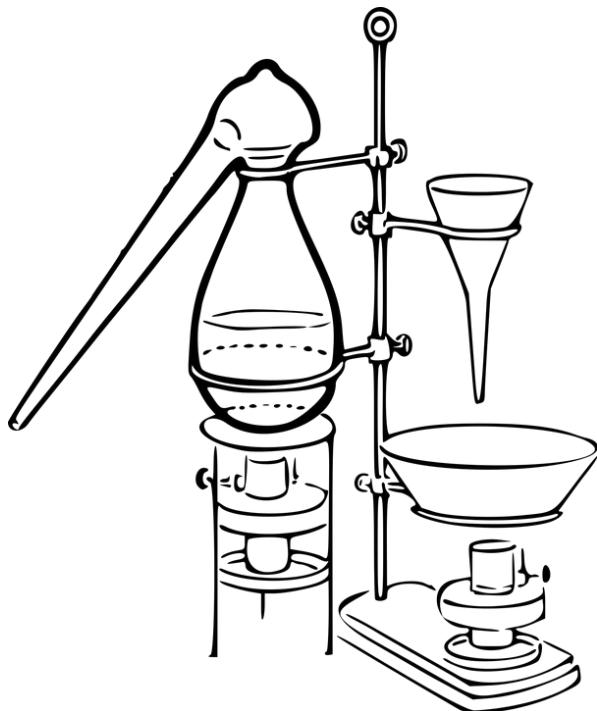
All About Me

Classroom Policies

- ➔ **Make Up Work**
