Earn up to 60 credit hours of college or an Associate's degree at no cost to the student.

What exactly is an early college high school? An early college high school is a small school located on or close to a college campus designed so students can earn both a high school diploma and an Associate's degree or up to two years of college credit toward a Bachelor's degree at no cost to the student.

Is Early College High School for me? Characteristics of a candidate for early college high school might include college readiness, maturity and a desire to attend college. Quest ECHS candidates must be willing and have the ability to spend time on academics and leave their home school campus. They must also give up participation in UIL activities such as band, orchestra and sports. An applicant may need help paying for college or be from one of the traditionally underrepresented groups defined by the Texas Education Agency.
