

101 (or More) and Out

Materials:

- 1 die per team/player **or** write the digits 1-6 on small pieces of paper to draw from a cup
- Paper to record numbers, see example recording sheet below

Goal:

To roll the die (or draw numbers) and add numbers to get to 100 without going over.

How to Play:

1. One person rolls the die (or draws a piece of paper)
2. Each number on the die represents the following value:

	1 or 10
	2 or 20
	3 or 30
	4 or 40
	5 or 50
	6 or 60

The team or player must decide on the value of the roll and record the decision onto the recording sheet.

3. Continue with next roll, there will be a total of six rolls and **every roll must be used!** Add the decided on value to the preceding roll.
4. Winner is the team/player whose rolls, when all added together, are closest to 100 without going over.
