Dear Scholarship Applicant,

The mission of the SCHS All-Sports Booster Club is to provide financial, volunteer and fan support for the full range of Summer Creek High School sports programs. We recognize the value of athletics and promote academic success through athletic development. In order to promote Summer Creek students beyond high school, the Booster Club has set up the Summer Creek High School All-Sports Booster Club Scholarship. Each year the Booster Club will accept applications from senior varsity athletes whose families are members of the Booster Club. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of outstanding moral character and work ethics displayed during their years at SCHS in the areas of athletics and academics.

Selected students will receive a \$1,000 scholarship based on application criteria which includes athletics, academics, leadership and a short, written essay. All scholarships will be paid directly to the college the athlete will be attending. The number of scholarships to be awarded will be determined during the Booster Club's budget process each year.

Your family must have paid membership dues for the current school year by February 1, 2020 (date of invoice).

The deadline for applying for the scholarship is March 31, 2020.

The application must be postmarked by March 31, 2020.

Applications may not be handed to a Coach or Athletic Director to be turned in on behalf of the athlete. Applications must be mailed according to the instructions below. Applications submitted not following the instructions below will be disqualified.

Scholarship Criteria

1. Completed a minimum of two (2) semesters at Summer Creek High School.
2. Attained a minimum of 3.0 out of 5.0 cumulative GPA. Transcripts are required to prove GPA and class rank.
3. Date of and proof the SAT or ACT has been taken, or is registered to be taken.
4. Must have participated in at least one (1) Varsity sport at SCHS during his/her SENIOR year and be eligible for graduation in the current school year.
5. Their Varsity Coach (in their senior year) must sign on p.2 of the application and confirm their participation.
6. Parent/Guardian must be a member of the SCHS All-Sports Booster Club (paid dues) by February 1st. Membership will be verified.
7. After selection of the scholarship recipient, and before scholarship presentation, if the recipient should break any rule of Humble ISD which requires disciplinary action and upon the vote of the majority of the members of the Scholarship Selection Committee, such scholarship recipient shall be withdrawn and the scholarship awarded to the applicant with the next highest point total.
8. Applications must be postmarked by March 31, 2012. The mailing address is

9. Applicant must plan to be enrolled in a college, university or technical institute by the following January after graduating from Summer Creek High School. Any scholarship recipient not providing the required payment information by the following January will forfeit his/her scholarship. The forfeited scholarship will not be awarded to another applicant.
10. Applicant must not be in the immediate family of a member of the SCHS All-Sports Booster Club Scholarship Selection Committee.
11. Signature on the application is required.
12. Letters of recommendation are required, and will earn the applicant additional points on his/her scholarship scoring. Applicant may include up to three (3) letters of recommendation. Letters of recommendation cannot be from family members or friends.

General Information

All information will be kept strictly confidential within the selection committee and school faculty. Scholarships not redeemed by December 31, 2020 will be forfeited. All decisions of the selection committee are final. Verification of sport participation and/or honors may be attained from the Coaches or Athletic Directors.

Applicants selected to receive a scholarship will be notified by the end of April via e-mail.

Scholarship awards will be presented at the May All-Sports Booster Club meeting.

Application Categories

The following categories are eligible for senior varsity athletes to apply for a scholarship. One scholarship application per athlete will be accepted regardless if the athlete participates in multiple categories.
