World History is a survey of the history of humankind. Major emphasis is on the study of significant people, events, ideas, and issues from the earliest times, approximately 10,000 BCE, to the present.

Classroom Expectations:

- **Be respectful.** Listen to your teacher. Listen to your classmates. Wait your turn to talk.

- Retest refusal form can be filled out if you do not wish to retake a test.
