Have someone read you the list of words and compete a "Practice" spelling test. Grade your own work. Rewrite any missed words correctly 3 more times.

Write your words in ABC order, then again in backwards ABC order.	Write each word as "Rainbow Words"  Pick any 3 colors	Look up 10 of the words in the dictionary. Write the definition, part of speech, pronunciation, and also the guide words listed.	Write each word, then use the Scrabble tiles on the back of this sheet to calculate the value of each of your words. Grimes = 2+1+1+3+1+1 = 9
Write the words 2x each with your right hand, then 2 more times each with your left hand. Go back and circle all the vowels with a colored pencil or marker.
