Visualize

When you visualize, you form a mental picture as you read or listen.

Generate Questions

A good reader asks questions about a text before, during, and after reading. Then they look for answers.

Make Predictions

When you predict, you use text clues, along with prior knowledge, to infer what might happen next in a story.

Make Inferences

Making inferences asks readers to call upon their understanding of the text, examine their own experiences, and then conclude certain information based on these Factors.

Evaluate

When you evaluate, you call upon your own critical judgment to understand a text

Summarizing

A summary is a short statement of the most important ideas in a passage or a text.
