

# Kool-Aid Play Dough

½ cup salt

2 ½ cups flour

2 packages Kool-Aid

3 tablespoons vegetable oil

2 cups boiling water

Directions: Mix the salt, flour, and Kool-Aid in a large bowl. Add oil and boiling water. Mix until just combined. Place mixture in a zip-lock bag. Seal the bag with as little air in the bag as possible. Wrap the bag loosely with a towel (as it will be **HOT**) and knead dough until all ingredients are well incorporated. Allow play dough to cool in the bag.

Note: If the water is not boiling at the time of use, the play dough will turn out sticky. For some reason, "lemonade" Kool-Aid does not work well with this recipe.

Storage: Store the play dough in the zip-lock bag for up to 6 months. No refrigeration needed.
