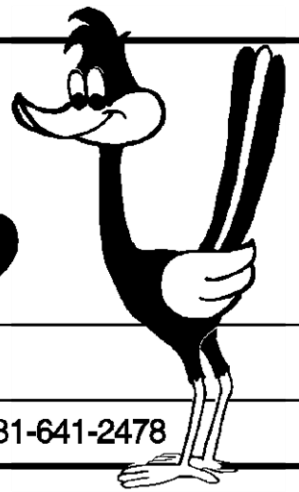

CONSTRUCTION OF NEW P.E. BUILDING
