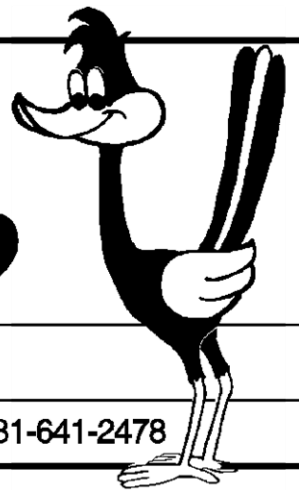

EPI School Supply Pack orders for students who will be in Kinder through 5<sup>th</sup> grade next year will be accepted through the secure online website only from now through June 1<sup>st</sup>. Late orders will be accepted June 2<sup>nd</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup>, possibly at a higher cost. Packs for K – 2<sup>nd</sup> cost \$42 and packs for 3 – 5 cost \$44. Please keep your online confirmation as your receipt. The supply packs will be available in your child's classroom when they begin classes in August.

## DRESS CODE

Spring is here, and we want to remind everyone of the dress code. Students should be dressed in a manner that is clean and neat and that will not be a hazard to themselves or others. In addition, students may not wear spaghetti strap tops, short shorts (**with arms at sides, shorts should reach the fingertips**), clothing that exposes the midriff, or clothing that is excessively loose or tight. The district dress code is detailed in the Humble ISD Student Handbook. Due to fluctuations in temperatures, your child may want to keep a light sweater at school, labeled with your child's name.

## It is strongly recommended that HHE students wear closed athletic/tennis shoes with backs every day.

Shoes with heels over 1/2" (including wedges), flip-flops, and wheeled shoes are prohibited for safety reasons by district policy. Croc type shoes are in fashion again, they are also discouraged for safety reasons.
